- You will provide your voice to help us listen to patients, families and carers who use and care about the service.
- You will advise on the look and feel of the new Bronglais Chemotherapy Day Unit .
- You will help deliver the Public Art Plan for the new Bronglais Chemotherapy Day Unit .

Who can be a Patient Representative?

- Those who are a current or past patient to the service
- Aged 18 and over
- Those who wish to be involved and take part in art projects which will help improve patient experience within the Bronglais Chemotherapy Day Unit
- Those with an enthusiasm and commitment to providing an inclusive voice for all patients within the service
- Those with a lived experience of the Bronglais Chemotherapy Day Unit

- Use your experience, to help get the atmosphere and artwork for the new unit right for patients, families, carers and staff.
- Be a proactive, enthusiastic, and inclusive participant in all activities to ensure the best outcomes
